



# Four leading community-based NGOs unite to launch a new international initiative

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#### Issues

The expression of the needs and priorities of PLWA and vulnerable groups needs to be reinforced. Therefore true involvement of people infected, affected or vulnerable to HIV/AIDS needs to be revitalized not only in the implementation of programs but also in the decision making process of organizations; that is in a comprehensive approach with the objective of societal transformation.

### Description

AIDES in France, ALCS (Association de Lutte Contre le Sida) in Morocco, ARCAD SIDA (Association de Recherche, de Communication et d'Accompagnement à Domicile des personnes vivant avec le VIH/SIDA) in Mali and COCQ-Sida (Coalition des Organismes Communautaires Québécois de Lutte contre le SIDA) in Quebec have been key players of the fight against

HIV/AIDS in their respective countries not only in providing care and support but also in influencing the decision making process for better policies.

- The texts regulating the governance of the organization ensure that members are respected and represented on the basis of democratic principles (authorities meet on a regular basis and public resolutions are recorded and available);
- The organization has implemented general and cost accounting which meet international standards;
- The organisation is able to provide audited accounts for years n-1 and n-2 by an independent firm;
- An annual activity report is established, covering all the actions of the organisation and/or possibly related organisations (foundation or federation).

### **Lessons** learned

Promoter of the community-based approach in the fight against HIV / AIDS, the initiative aims to expand to new associations. The latter will have the option, subject to compliance with a number of criteria to become members and thus benefit from a material and financial support as well as ownership of the initiative (voting rights). In addition, the initiative is also meant to offer technical support to organizations wishing to become a member of the initiative but who do not entirely fulfill the criteria.

## **Country of research**

Canada, France, Mali, Morocco.

### Criteria to become a member

- The organisation is legally recognised in its country;
- The fight against HIV / AIDS is the primary object of the organisation;
- The objective of general interest aiming at "societal" transformation" or any equivalent concept is clearly expressed in the goals of the organisation;
- The community-based approach is the operating principle of the organisation;
- Infected people are present and involved in coordinating the organization whether they are members or by holding office in the organization's executive bodies (Board of Directors or equivalent body);
